Treasurer's Report Highlights – July 2023 YE Financial Report

July 2023 Financial Statements

- Favorable budget variance at \$32K mainly due to \$32K favorable variance due to increased interest rates on CD's.
- AR increased by \$26K to \$51K mainly due to July 2023 semi-annual assessments charges. Total AR is \$5K higher than the same period last year. Neighborhood assessments, Legal and Late fees are higher than last year, while Base assessments and Fines/Misc are lower.
- Collections remain at 8 accounts totaling \$30K, which is 59% of AR.
- \$0 was over the FDIC limit.

Sanjay moves to approve the July 2023 Financial Reports, seconded by Bertan. all present voted aye, motion approved.

Executive Director's Report Highlights

- Vantaca software conversation in progress. Main priority through November.
- High Street Center budget preparations: have begun for the 2024 calendar year for the Grand Plaza Area to include Westridge, Swedish, Shelter Holdings, Heartwood, Discovery Apartments etc. Draft will be presented to the Finance Committee in October. Billing in Decembre for January 1 billing statement due date.
- Holiday Lighting Project: Holiday lighting prep in progress. Tree trimming and outlet work is in progress this week. Light will be lit right before Thanksgiving break and will come down by mid- February._
