TREASURER'S REPORT

March 24 Draft FC Meeting Minutes

Ryan moves to accept the March 12, 2024 meeting minutes, seconded by Paul all present voted aye, motion approved.

February 2024 Financial Statements

- Favorable budget variance is \$164K (\$53K change from last month) mainly due to \$143K favorable variance in Payroll/Benefits {down 1 landscape (not actively hiring for) & no CARC assistant}, \$29K favorable variance in Interest Income due to higher interest rates, and (\$8K) net unfavorable variance for accounts under \$10K.
- AR decreased by \$27K to \$48K. Total AR is \$9K higher than the same period last year. Neighborhood & Base assessments, Legal fees & Late fees are higher than last year, while Fines/misc. are lower.
 Neighborhood assessments are higher mainly due to one Concord Commons account in collections for \$17.8K (includes special assessment), and higher legal fees are due to increased collection efforts.
- Regular Collections remains at 6 accounts totaling \$36K, which is 74% of regular AR.
 - The CC account in collections has filed for bankruptcy owing \$17.8K (including special assessment). Attorneys are filing a notice of appearance on behalf of the IHCA. We will update if the chapter 13 gets accepted or dismissed.
- No accounts are over the FDIC limit.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Memo - 2024/25 Supplemental Budgets (Final)

David moves to approve the final budgets for the 11 IHCA Supplemental neighborhoods, seconded by Ryan, all present voted aye, motion approved.

2. Memo – High Street Townhomes – Leak Investigation

Paul moves to approve the reserve expense for a leak investigation at 998 NE High Street totaling \$1,610.76, seconded by Ryan, all present voted aye, motion approved.
