Call to Order

Jeremy Fallt called the meeting to order at 4:02 (Pacific Time) and Eric Wolak recorded the minutes. A quorum of directors was present, and the meeting, having been duly convened, was ready to proceed with business.

Approval of Minutes

Motion: Minutes for September were approved with some minor edits

Manager’s Report

Jeremy sent out the report for September via email. No questions were raised.

BNG Upgrade Project

Several board members have switched over to the BNG successfully, and testing is going well. A licensing issue with the underlying software caused some trouble several weeks ago.

Jeremy is working with GigabitNow to coordinate more pilot volunteer customers.

XGS-PON Upgrade Project

Deployment of new XGS-PON hardware to pilot sites is blocked on a subtle licensing issue with the equipment vendor, which is now resolved.

Connections conversion

Motion: HFN will commit to the increased marketing budget proposal offered by Highlands Council with a 50/50 split in sharing the costs with GigabitNow.. The motion passed unanimously.

Multi-mode / single-mode drop vendor

After some initial hurdles, the new cable contractor successfully completed the challenging drop upgrade.

XGS-PON Marketing

Jeremy presented some concepts for a more experience-oriented marketing approach, in place of the current focus on raw speeds. The new Calix equipment will open up new opportunities to sell service add-ons above and beyond raw bandwidth.

Splicing Van

The new splicing van has been wrapped and is out serving the community.

Broadband Consumer Labels

HFN's Broadband Fact Labels are now live on the website.

Insurance

HFN has signed a new insurance contract to adjust coverage.
